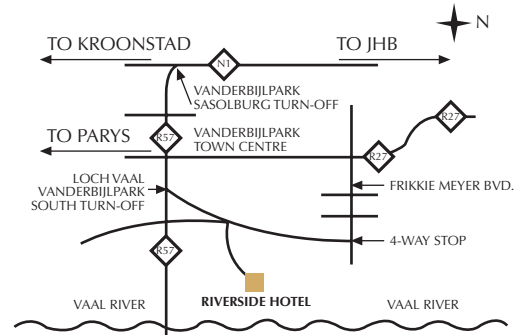

RIVERSIDE HOTEL: Directions

Take the N1 South to Roodepoort. Continue on the N1 South towards Bloemfontein. Do not take the alternative route Vanderbijlpark/Ennerdale. Continue through the Grassmere Toll Plaza. Pass the De Deur/Ennerdale and Vereeniging/Randfontein off-ramps. Take the next off-ramp, R57 to Vanderbijlpark/Sasolburg.

Cross one stop street and three traffic lights. Bophelong is on your right. Follow the Sasolburg signs on the R57. After the third traffic light, travel for 2,5 km until you reach a brown sign marked "Riverside Sun/Stonehaven". Take this off-ramp and turn left at the top into Ravel Street. At the first stop, turn right into Beethoven Street and at the next stop, turn right into Chopin Street. Go over the three-way stop into Wenning Street and follow the road to the hotel, which is on your left-hand side.
